City Academy transforms children, families, and our community through exceptional education and bold expectations that empower children to overcome barriers. The school was founded in 1999 by Don Danforth and Duncan Marshall on the belief that all families deserve access to affordable, high-quality academic programs regardless of income or zip code. We are the only private, independent elementary school in St. Louis and Missouri that provides scholarship support to 100% of our scholars.



EXCEPTIONAL EDUCATION

City Academy faculty are specialists in their subject areas. Through this specialist model, City Academy scholars receive greater depth of instruction in a subject area that supports the level of academic rigor expected of students. Education and support for our scholars continue after graduation. Through alumni programs, City Academy's 295 alumni are provided with transition support to other independent, private schools; college readiness through our Strive for College program at Washington University in St. Louis; and leadership development through community service and networking events.
